Spiked Washington Apple

This crafted cocktail with our house-infused spiced rum, hot spiced local cider topped with an apple slice 9

Prospector Berry Mule

This mule is full of flavor muddled with fresh blackberries, lime and vodka topped with house made ginger beer. 9

Hot Buttered Rum

This cocktail is full of flavors from our house-made batter and our full-bodied infused spiced rum. 9

Canyon Espresso Martini

This crafted martini has our house-made espresso vodka, Baileys, cream and chocolate 12

Bourbon Hard Cherry

This is a fun mix on a cherry coke mixed up with our house-made cherry bourbon and our cherry cordial. 9

This is a step above the rest with our jalapeno- infused vodka and our special recipe bloody Mary mix and local pickled items 10

Pumpkin Patch Cocktail

This playful pumpkin cocktail is made with our fresh local pumpkin puree and our canyon river spiced rum, cream and garnished with whipped cream. 12

Hunters Bulleit Bourbon & Beef

This bold drink has Bulliet bourbon, sweet vermouth, Aperol, lemon juice & garnished with beef jerky. 12

Wine by the glass

Coach House Cellars Chardonnay

This wine offers flavors of ripe pear and mellon upfront with a crisp acidity and a smooth creamy finish. Pairs well with our Steelhead. 8/25

Sheridan Crossfork Creek Merlot

With flavors of cassis, cinnamon and toasty oak. Pairs well with our Lemon Pepper Chicken. 10/31

Coach House Cellars Cabernet

Aromas of boysenberry, cedar and black currant in the nose. Structured and full bodied with flavors of cassis, black plum and black cherry 10/35

Coach House Cellars Garage Red

This Bordeaux blend of 70% Cabernet and 30% Merlot is a soft, plump and generous on the palate with flavors of blackberry and vanilla with cola. 7/23

Owen Roe Riesling

This Yakima Valley wine has a beautiful texture, while the clean, natural acidity provides a focused attack of a crisp finish. 9/29

NHV Can Can White

This great white blend of 21% Pinot Gris, 17% Riesling, 11% Viognier, 7% Gewurtranner, 6% Gruner Veltliner. Pairs well with our NW Cavatappi. 8/24

Cultura Rose'

100% CINSAULT, Marcella Vineyard, Yakima Valley AVA - No oak, low tannin and 1% residual sugar - this Rose' is supple on the palate. Pairs well with grilled chicken, fresh seafood, 11/34

Cultura 2012 Vintage One

50% CAB SAUV, 25% MALBEC, 12.5% MERLOT, 12.5% CAB FRANC, Pisel-Wilbur Vineyard, Columbia Valley AVA - Aged in neutral French oak barrels. Pairs well with our broiled Rib-eye. 12/37

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Wines by the bottle

Gilbert Cellars 2013 Syrah

This wine is a beautiful magenta that literally coats the glass. On the nose it displays rich blackberry type fruits accented by a wonderful floral lift. 42

Gilbert Cellars Riesling

Honey-crisp apple, basil, and mineral on the nose. Pairs well with cheeses or a wide variety of Asian curries. 32

Maryhill Moscato

Golden color. Floral aromas mingle with notes of crisp apple and honey. Balanced by a lovely acidity are hints of bartlett pear, apple and peach compote. 24

Gilbert Cellars 2013 The Grower

A soft white blend with hints of oak and fruits. 35

Cultura 2013 Estate Zinfandel

100% ZINFANDEL, Fewel Family Estate Vineyard - From the vines to the bottle-this wine receives hands on attention throughout the whole wine-making process.

With notes of citrus, peppercorn, all spice and honey.

Pairs well with smoked pork chop, pad Thai and homemade Yakima apple pie. 61

Cultura 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon

100% CAB SAUVIGNON, Sun Ridge Vineyard Yakima Valley AVA - Rich in tannins, structured oak profiles and a velvet touch on the tongue. Pairs well with Rib Eye steak, garlic mashed fingerling potatoes, fresh mozzarella tomato & basil salad. 55

Cultura 2012 Chronos

50% CAB SAUV, 25% MERLOT, 25% CAB FRANC, Sun Ridge & Meek & Fewel Estate Vineyards, Yakima Valley AVA - 3 vineyard blend Bordeaux, sourced from the Yakima Valley terroir. Pairs well with pasta dishes, dry rubbed Prime Rib roast and roasted summer squash. 49

Cultura 2013 Kairos

50% MERLOT & 50% CAB FRANC Inland Desert & Sun Ridge & Fewel Vineyards Yakima Valley AVA - We have been making this wine since our beginnings in the Washington wine industry in 2005. Plenty of fruit, lush and ample oak. Pairs well with lamb, prime rib or rib eye, and anything with dark chocolate. 49

Cultura 2013 Estate Cabernet Franc

100% CAB FRANC, Fewel Family Estate Vineyard, Yakima Valley AVA. Full of fruit, aromas of wood smoke and anise. What a delight! Barrel aged for 2+ years in a blend of new French oak and neutral barrels. Pairs well with prime rib, mushroom risotto, lamb and roasted root vegetables. 49

Canyon River Ranch's Release 2012

The 2012 Release comes from our very own vineyard located on the Canyon River Ranch. It's a meaty, beefy, smoky wine. Smoked meats, cured bacon fat, chocolate, blackcurrants and licorice nuances flow to a full-bodied, impeccably balanced, seamless Syrah that has nicely integrated acidity, ripe tannin and a great finish. 65

Sheridan Block 1 Reserve Cab Franc

The sensational 2014 Block 1 is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon that was brought up all in new French oak. It's an extraordinary Cabernet from Washington that will easily stand up to the first growths of Bordeaux in a blind tasting. Tobacco leaf, blackcurrants, toasted bread, lead pencil and spice are just some of the nuances here, and it's full-bodied, silky and seamless on the palate. 149

Sheridan L'Orange

Cab Sauv based, with a small amount of Cab Franc, from the same two blocks, Notes of Cassis, leafy herbs, smoke tobacco, lead pencil shavings and incense all give way to a full-bodied, decadent, sexy red. It tastes like a blend of Pontet Canet and Shafer Hillside Select. 70

Sheridan Boss Block Cab Franc

The 2014 Boss Block yields serious notes of black fruits, damp earth, dark chocolate and leafy herbs.

These flow to a rich, full-bodied wine that has an expansive, voluptuous texture, gorgeous mid-palate concentration and a great finish. Reminding me of the 2008 Cheval Blanc (it has a voluptuousness on the palate similar to the 2009!), it remains to be seen how well this cuvee evolves, but my money is firmly on it have two decades of longevity. It's unquestionably the greatest vintage of this cuvee made and should not be missed. 65
